Ramveer Tanwar, who gave up a very good job to clean and restore lakes.


Radhika Shastry, a cafe owner, who started auto ambulances for humans and animals because the roads were too narrow to allow a regular ambulance.

And many more, who did not take the easy road but the one less walked on, so that they could do something useful for their fellow human beings, for animals and the environment.




